Warnings

- Do not install batteries backwards. Do not open battery or put in a fire. Do not mix alkaline, standard, or rechargeable batteries in the same compartment. Do not mix old and new batteries. The batteries may explode or leak causing injury.
- Follow the instructions carefully on articles to be inflated, never exceed recommended pressure. Bursting items can cause serious injury.
- Do not open case, electrical hazards may result. There are no user serviceable parts.
- Do not use under wet conditions. Keep away from water.
- Do not use or place near heaters, open flame or other hot objects.
- Never look into or point any opening toward your eyes while pump is operating.
- Do not attempt to put any objects into the inflation or deflation port at any time.
- Never leave pump unattended while in use.
- Never allow sand, paper, debris or small articles to be sucked into pump while operating.
- DO NOT BLOCK THE AIR VENTS DURING OPERATION, THIS COULD DAMAGE THE MOTOR.**

Caution: Air temperature and weather do affect the air pressure in inflatable products. In cold weather your airbed will lose some pressure due to the fact that the air will contract. If this occurs, you may want to add a little air to improve your airbed's performance. However, in hot weather, the air will expand. You must let some air out to prevent the airbed from failing due to overpressure. You should avoid exposing your airbed to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).

Inflation Instructions

1. Make sure the Control Dial is in OFF position. (Fig. 1)
2. Unroll and layout airbed in position. Close secondary valve as shown in “**Double Lock™ Valve Operation**”. Valve should appear depressed into itself. (Fig. 2)
3. Turn control dial to INFLATE and begin inflation. When bed is fully inflated, turn dial to OFF position. (Fig. 3)

NOTE:

To adjust firmness briefly turn control dial:

DEFLATE decreases firmness.

INFLATE increases firmness.

Deflation Instructions

To Deflate using the Built-in Pump:

1. Make sure the Double Lock™ Valve is closed. (Fig. 4)
2. Turn Control dial to DEFLATE position. (Fig. 5)

To Deflate without use of pump:

1. To deflate, open external stopper and pull to extend out allowing air to escape. When fully deflated close stopper. (Fig. 6)

Battery instructions

1. Always purchase the correct size and grade of battery most suitable for the intended use.
2. Replace all batteries of a set at the same time.
3. Clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
4. Remove batteries from equipment that is not to be used for an extended period of time.
5. Remove used batteries promptly.

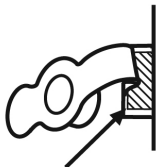
Important Things You Should Know

- Carefully inspect the pump for damage before first use and every use thereafter. Do not use if found damaged.
- Keep unit out of reach of children.
- Do not expose to rain or sunlight. Household use only.

DOUBLE LOCK™ VALVE OPERATION

To Open Valve

OPEN - STEP 1:

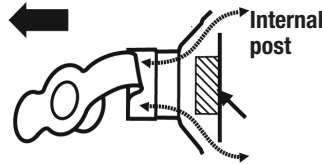


Internal seal closed

- Pull open cap.

OPEN - STEP 2:

Pull to Open



Fully Opened Valve

- Firmly pull cap to unseat valve from inner post.

To Close Valve

Push to Close



Internal Seal Closed

- Reverse Steps 1 & 2. Make sure valve seats on inner post.



Fully Closed Valve

- Close cap.

To Insert/Replace Batteries

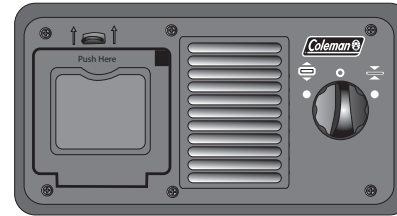

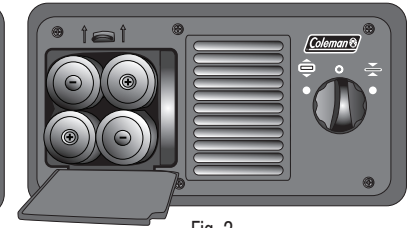

- Make sure pump is “OFF”.
- Press up on latch to open battery cover (Fig. 1).
- Insert 4 “D” cell batteries as shown. Make sure batteries are installed in the correct orientation following the + and - symbols (Fig. 2).
- Close the battery cover, making sure it is latched.

NOTE: Alkaline batteries are recommended for optimum performance. Do not mix battery types. Do not mix old & new batteries.

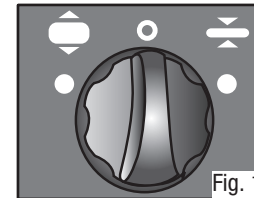

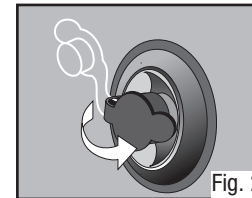

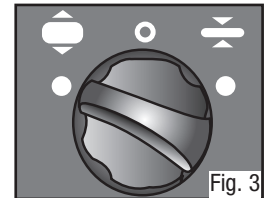

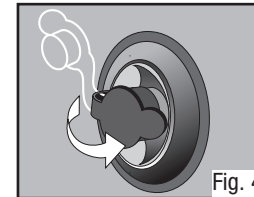

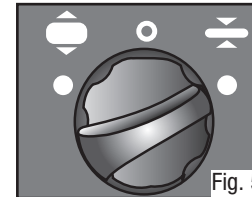
